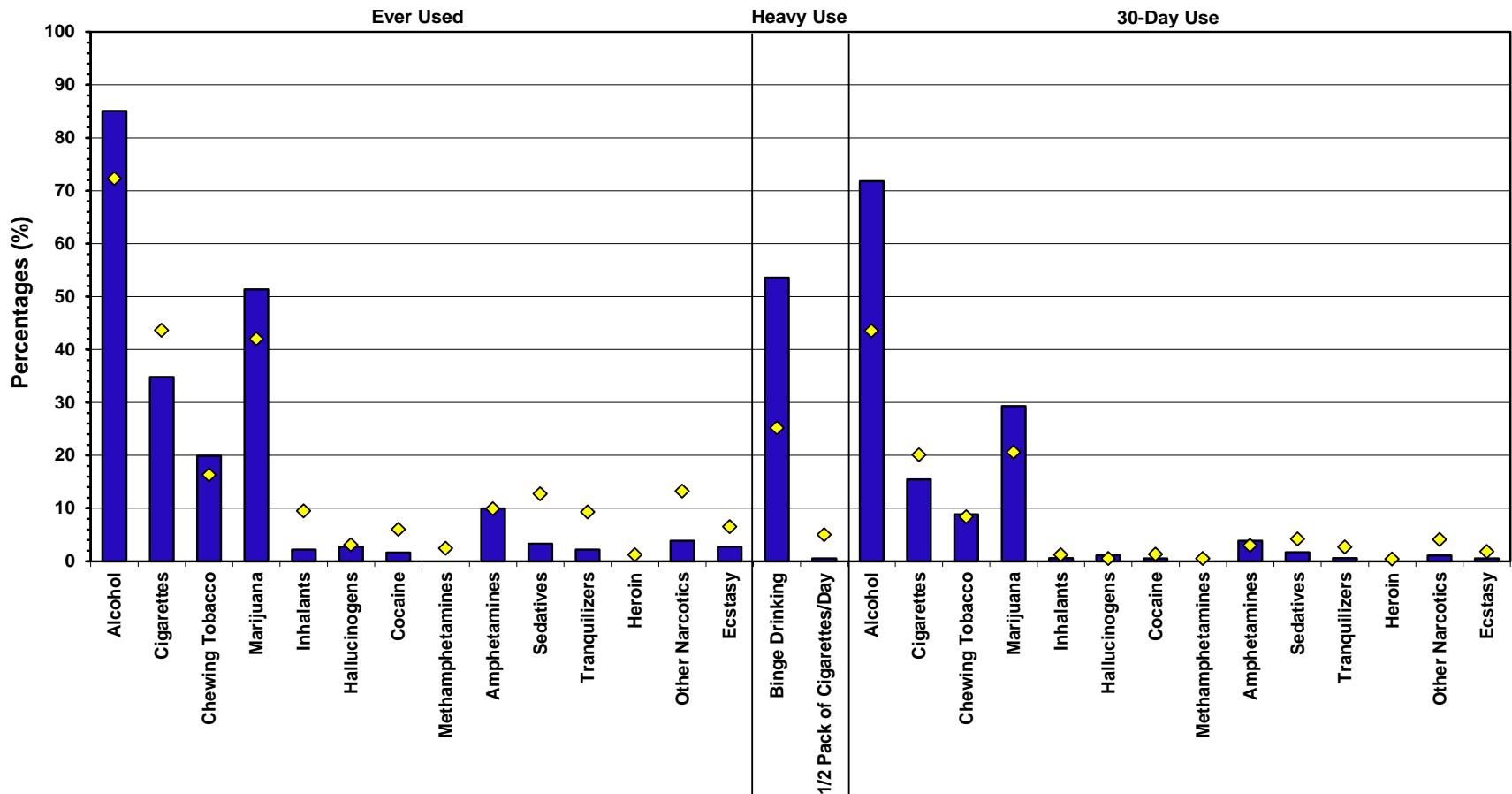

Sources and Places of Teen Drinking

- **91.4%** report getting alcohol at a party;
- **76.6 %** report drinking alcohol at my home or someone else's home *without your permission*;
- **57.9%** report drinking alcohol at someone else's home *with their parent's permission*;
- **51.7%** report getting alcohol from home *without your permission*;



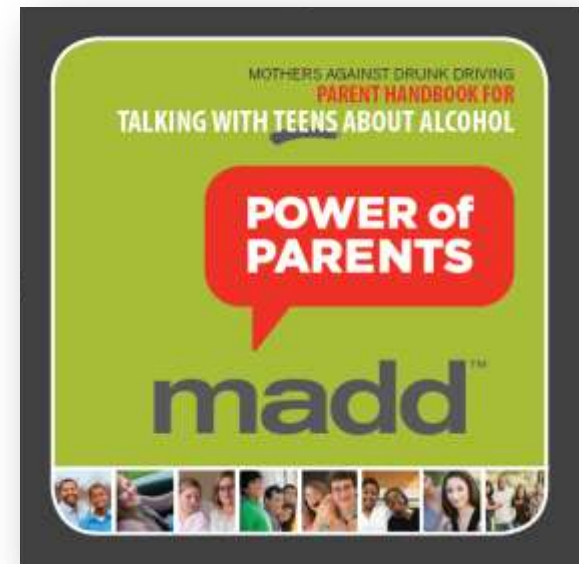

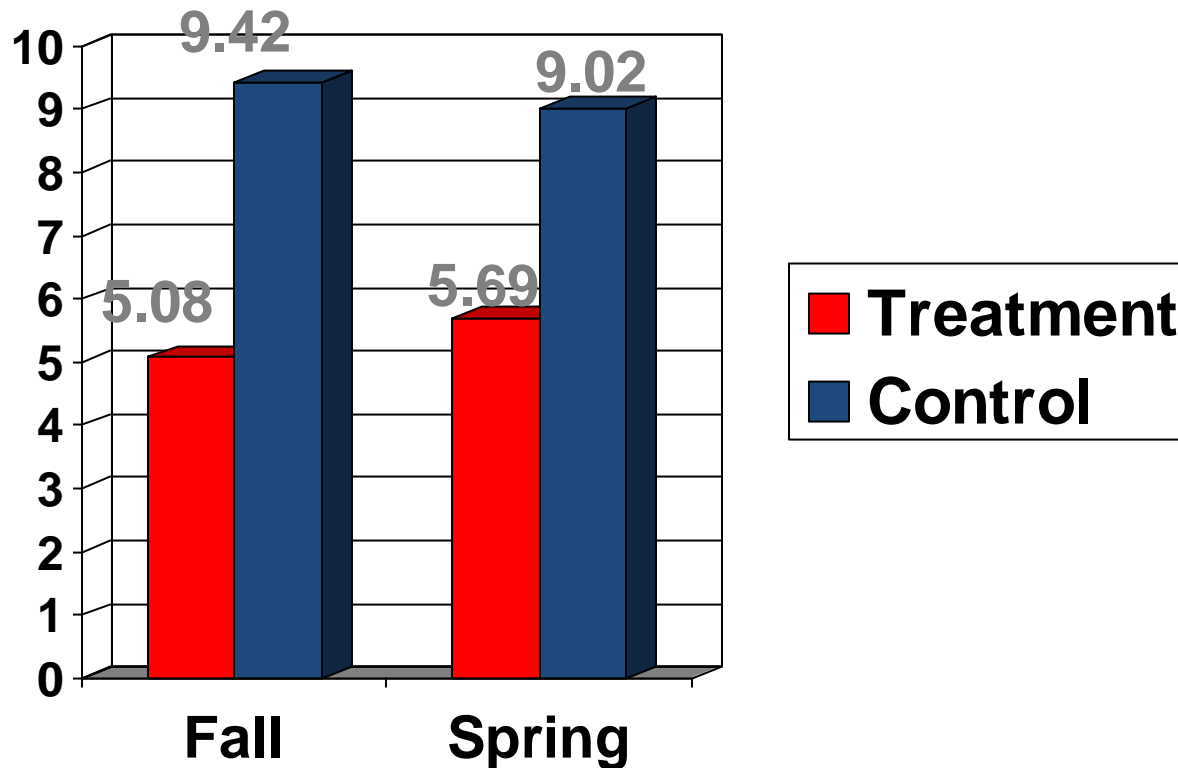
38.2% of Seniors drank alcohol in a car
