Dr. Dewey's career includes a 24year tenure at the Brookhaven National Laboratory, where he conducted research on the effects of addictive drugs on the human brain. Since 2009, Dr. Dewey's research program has been operating at the Center

for Neurosciences at the Feinstein Institute for Medical Research at North Shore-LIJ. In 1994, Dr. Dewey started an outreach program bringing his research findings to schools throughout Long Island and the tri-state area.
