




## Manhasset Youth Self-Report

Underage & Binge Drinking Above National Norms (Grades 10/12)



Manhasset students who reported drinking alcohol in the Past 30 Days - NOT just a sip or taste



Manhasset students who reported binge drinking (5 or more alcoholic drinks in a row in the past 2 weeks - one or more times)

### HOW DO TEENS GET THEIR ALCOHOL?

- 59.8% GOT IT FROM SOMEONE THEY KNOW UNDER 21
- 79.2% GOT IT AT A PARTY
- 53.2% GAVE SOMEONE ELSE MONEY TO BUY IT


### UNDERAGE DRINKING STARTS WITH PARENT PERMISSION

- They're safer if they drink in my home, under my supervision
- I drank when I was their age and I turned out just fine
- It's okay my kid knows the limit
- I want my kid and their friend to think I'm cool so they'll open up to me
- It's just a few drinks... at least they're not doing drugs
