Last year, over 70,000 Americans died from overdoses involving illegally made fentanyl. Shockingly, on average, 22 teenagers aged 14 to 18 died each week in 2022 from drug overdoses, frequently as a result of taking counterfeit pills containing fentanyl. Regrettably, nearly 40% of all overdose deaths and 67% of adolescent overdose deaths had a bystander present who could have intervened by administering the overdose-reversal medication Narcan(naloxone), but they didn't. Being trained and having Narcan can save lives.
